2. RECORD OF DECISIONS TAKEN

- 1) Minutes were approved for the following meetings:
 - Council Meeting held on 10th February 2022.
 - Biodiversity Committee Meeting held on 3rd March 2022.
- 2) Matters arising from the Council Meeting held on 10th February 2022 were discussed and noted.
- 3) Members reviewed the latest position with the Village Hall interested party and noted the withdrawal of the expression of interest from Trelawnyd Community Association. Members resolved to offer the tenancy to the remaining interested party. Clerk was authorised to investigate options to draw up a suitable lease.
- 4) The Clerk provided their monthly report.
- 5) The Clerk was requested to write to Natural Resource Wales, concerning Ty Isaf Farm Slurry Pit, and ask for a position statement.

- 6) Members approved the monthly accounts for payment.
- 7) Correspondence was noted as circulated by the Clerk.
- 8) Members noted the 2022/23 determinations from the IRPW, and would consider any discretionary determinations at the Annual Meeting in May 2022.
